PUBLIC NOTICE:

PROPOSED PERMITS FOR NET PEN AQUACULTURE FACILITIES DISCHARGING TO RUFUS WOODS LAKE IN WASHINGTON

Summary

EPA is proposing to reissue its National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permits to Pacific Aquaculture, Inc. (Sites 1-3) and Faith Frontier Ministries.

Pacific Aquaculture and Faith Frontier Ministries have currently permitted net pens. The four net pen facilities are located in waters of the Confederated Tribes of the Colville Reservation (**CTCR**) in Rufus Woods Lake, an impoundment of the Columbia River behind Chief Joseph Dam in central Washington State. The effluent from the facilities is discharged to Rufus Woods Lake. In order to ensure protection of water quality and human health, the permits place requirements to minimize the discharge of pollutants.

Tentative Determination

The Region 10 office of the EPA has tentatively determined to reissue a discharge permit to the applicants.
